

DANCE RESEARCH NRW #17 Bonn (english)

PERIOD: August – October 2015

HOST: Bonn (CocoonDance & die Bundesstadt Bonn)

Informations for applicants:

1. Dance Research NRW is not a production-fund. The program intends to support profound research in relation to dance and performance.
2. Applicants: choreographers, dancers or performers may apply for research projects. Applicants should have established an individual artistic signature and be able to communicate their intent and its interest.
3. Participants: one or two persons can participate in the research project in Bonn.
4. Thematic focus : Identity is not tied to a specific location. Yet globalisation and migration question the conventional concepts of space. Only in movement can we experience locations and make them accessible with our body and thus create the space we can then connect to stories. The **Dance Research NRW #17** in **Bonn** is devoted to the question of how these body and spatial experiences can be artistically tangible as a political and aesthetic category.
5. Communication: Participants should have substantial German or English language skills.
6. Accommodation: a rent-free accommodation in Bonn is available from August till October 2015 for maximum 12 weeks and for one or 2 persons.
7. Mentoring and moderation: personal support will be granted in Bonn. The NRW KULTUR-sekretariat (represented by jury members and the project management) will offer organisational help and mentoring.
8. Grants: € 1500 per person per month will be granted.
9. Material and travel cost subsidies: material and travel costs needed for the accomplishment of the research can be reimbursed up to € 1500 per research project based on giving prior notice and the actual expenditures.
10. Rent subsidies: under specific circumstances participants can receive rent subsidies for their own apartment.
11. Research information should include: the research duration (6-12 weeks), the preferred time period (between August and Oktober 2015), the title, a detailed description, as well as the goals, methodologies and the approach to the project.
Please note that your text cannot be longer than the respective field.
12. not obligatory project information: we would like you to write a summary of the production or the project that is eventually linked to the research. Please, also write a list of any further significant project dates as well as any potential cooperation partners. Further, please submit an outline of the financial costs.
13. The results of the research will be presented at an official event at the end of the residency.
14. Please submit in attachment to your email: a significant CV // a photo of the participant(s) // References and press clippings.
15. You can submit your application via Email until February 15th, 2015.

16. The jury meeting is scheduled for April 10th, 2015. The result will be announced afterwards.
